

The purpose of this work is to review the literature on nursing responsibility and relate it to the experience of continuing education developed within a hospital case.

The study started with the training, consisting of two parts (legal and ethical responsibility), as well as a close follow-up of the participants by sending them questionnaires related to the content of the training and identification sheets. This follow-up enabled us to ensure the effective participation of nurses in training.
